- 3 One exhibit only from any one exhibitor in any one class
- 4 Pot plants to have been in the possession of exhibitor for 6 months
- 5 The Committee shall appoint judges whose decisions are final. Judges will be guided by the RHS Horticultural Show Handbook, but may use their discretion
- 6 The Committee shall take all ordinary care of exhibits, but cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage incurred
- 7 Trophies to be held for one year and be returned to the Show Secretary at least one week before the next Spring Show

Hall opens at 8.30 am on day of show

Exhibits to be brought before 10.00 am when exhibitors must leave the hall

Judging commences at 10.15 am

No exhibits to be removed before 4.30 pm

2	Long trumpet , outer petals white or cream, trumpet white or cream - 3 blooms
3	Long trumpet, any other combination - 3 blooms
4	Long trumpet, outer petals yellow, trumpet yellow - 1 bloom
5	Long trumpet, outer petals white or cream, trumpet white or cream - 1 bloom
6	Long trumpet, any other combination - 1 bloom
7	Medium trumpet, outer petals yellow, trumpet yellow - 3 blooms
8	Medium trumpet, outer petals white or cream, trumpet white or cream - 3 blooms
9	Medium trumpet, outer petals yellow, trumpet orange or red- 3 blooms
10	Medium trumpet, outer petals white or cream, trumpet orange or red - 3 blooms
11	Medium trumpet, any other combination - 3 blooms
12	Short trumpet,outer petals white or cream,any trumpet colour-1 bloom colour-3 blooms
13	Short trumpet, outer petals yellow, any trumpet colour - 3 blooms
14	Short trumpet, outer petals yellow, any trumpet colour - 1 bloom
15	Short trumpet, outer petals white or cream, any trumpet colour - 1 bloom
16	Double blooms, outer petals yellow, centre yellow - 3 blooms
17	Double blooms, outer petals white or cream, centre white or cream - 3 blooms
18	Double blooms, outer petals yellow, centre any other combination - 3 blooms
19	Double blooms, outer petals white or cream, centre any other combination- 3 blooms
20	Daffodils and/or Narcissi, 6 different varieties - 6 stems
21	Miniature daffodils single - 3 stems
22	Miniature daffodils multiflowers - 3 stems
23	Narcissi Poetaz (multiflowers) - 3 stems

OTHER FLOWERS

24	Tulips, any variety of Darwin cupped type bloom - 3 blooms
25	Tulips, any variety of other shaped blooms - 3 blooms
26	Hyacinth - 1 spike

38	Pot plant, flowering, bulbous, maximum pot diameter 8½"
39	Pot plant, grown for foliage, maximum pot diameter 5½"
40	Pot plant, grown for foliage, pot diameter greater than 5½"
41	One cactus, maximum pot diameter 6½"
42	One succulent, maximum pot diameter 6½"
43	Collection of Cacti, 4 pots, pot diameter less than 6½", displayed on a tray
44	Collection of shrubs in flower for the Doris Hammond trophy

EXHIBITORS' NOTES

- 1 Long trumpet: when trumpet is as long, or longer than the petals
- 2 Medium trumpet: when trumpet is longer than 1/3 of the length, but less than equal to the length, of the outer petals
- 3 Short trumpet: when trumpet is less than 1/3 the length of the outer petals
